Mt. Enterprise ISD Cell Phone Policy – Consequences for Violations

In compliance with House Bill 1481 (Effective Aug 18, 2025)

Covered Devices:

- · Cell phones
- Smartwatches
- Earbuds/headphones
- Tablets and other personal communication devices

Policy Summary:

Students are **not allowed to use or access personal electronic devices at any time during the school day**, including **before school, during passing periods, lunch, and dismissal**. All devices must remain **off and out of sight** from arrival until the end of the instructional day.

▲ Consequences for Violations

Offense	Consequence
1st Offense	Device is confiscated and held in the office until the end of the school day. Parent/guardian is notified. Student receives a documented warning.
2nd Offense	Device is held in the office. Parent/guardian must pick up the device in person at the end of the school day.
3rd Offense	Same as above, plus 1 day of In-School Suspension (ISS) . Referral to administrator for further action.
4th Offense	2 days ISS , parent conference required. Student may lose privileges (e.g. extracurriculars, assemblies).
5th Offense or More	Considered persistent misbehavior. May result in out-of-school suspension , DAEP, behavior intervention plan, or loss of other privileges.

Important Notes

- Only **parents or legal guardians** may retrieve confiscated devices.
- Students with **documented medical, safety, or educational needs** will be accommodated as required by law. (504, IEP)
- Refusal to surrender a device when asked will be considered defiance of authority and may result in additional disciplinary action.
