

# Summer Drama Camp 2016

Dear Junior High Parent,

We are excited and preparing for this summer's drama camp. The dates for this summer's camp will be August 8<sup>th</sup> through the 11<sup>th</sup>. The schedule has changed since I first sent out information at the end of the school year in order to accommodate staff training that teachers must attend on Friday. The activities will be held in the MHS auditorium. Camp begins at 9:00 a.m. and will end each day at 12:00 noon Monday through Wednesday. We have extended the day from 9:00 to 3:00 p.m. on Thursday. Lunch will be provided for the campers that day. Throughout the week, Mr. Fryman and I will teach the campers basic theatre skills including confidence building, cooperation, public speaking, creativity, movement, stage combat, stage design, personal responsibility and concentration. These skills will be taught through a variety of activities designed to help the students learn how these skills are incorporated in the theatre setting as well as in their daily lives and in their future endeavors.

The fee for the week of camp is \$40.00. The fee includes: the week's activities, a snack and drink each day, lunch on Friday, and a drama tee shirt. Checks should be made payable to Mount Enterprise ISD. Fees are due by Wednesday, August 10<sup>th</sup>. If your child opts not to attend the entire camp after Tuesday, no fee will be charged.

Students who enjoy camp and would like to continue are encouraged to continue their learning experience as participants in the University Interscholastic League's Junior High One Act Play. We will hold auditions for campers Thursday afternoon the 11<sup>th</sup> after lunch. All campers who would like to audition are encouraged to do so. However, please remind your camper that not every student will get the part he or she desires, and some may not be cast at all. This is tough, but it is a part of the process that we would like students to be prepared to accept if they plan to audition that afternoon.
